Find a doctor in your plan's network

Our **Find Care** tool helps you find healthcare professionals and facilities in your plan's network.

- Search in the text box under Use Member ID for Basic Search and enter the alphanumeric prefix applicable below and select Continue:

 - For Wisconsin: V7W
 - All other states: V6L
- 3. Enter your location and search by facility name, doctor name, specialty, or procedure. Select a doctor to get details such as specialties, languages spoken, training, gender, and contact information.



Transition of care

We're here to help make sure the transition to Anthem is smooth for you. If you currently receive care for a health condition and your doctor is not in the Anthem plan's network, call an Anthem Health Guide at **833-401-1592**. Your new plan may cover services from your current doctor for a certain period of time. Anthem will help you safely transfer to the care of a doctor who is in your plan's network.



Manage your health with the Sydney Health app

Once you enroll in an Anthem health plan, download the **Sydney Health app** from the App Store® or Google Play™. Log in to the **Sydney Health app** or your account at **anthem.com/ca** to view your benefits and ID card, connect to virtual care, and access health and wellness resources.

Log in to myapps.corelogic.com and select the Benefits Enrollment (YBR) icon or scan the QR code using the camera on your smartphone to choose your benefits.
